Europe of Libraries


- Protestant North

The existence of the libraries cannot be taken for granted

- Funding: a wide spread financial crisis challenging local economy all over Europe
- Politics: Neo liberals and national populists are not in favor of publicly funded libraries
- Competition of your spare time: TV, Social media and other forms of information and entertainment are challenging libraries' and book's traditional position
- Yes, and the e-book, too



How do we get it funded, then?

- · Lobbing: politicians, civil servants
- Publicity: we want people to talk about libraries
- Electoral support. People do love the libraries, and they do vote in the elections

How do we lobby, then?

- Cabinets loosing their power
- Personal engagement: bring the politicians in (Sun Tzu: to win your opponent, ask him for a favor)
- Politician is looking for the same things as we are:
 Staying in the business, and having sufficient support
- We can help one another
